Say Hello to George

Meet George Barthelmes, who has served as our Vice President for 2023-24. George was born and raised in Leicester, MA and moved to Lake City with his family when he was 17, in 1987. He married his wife Wanda in 1995 and they have lived in Bryceville, FL since then. They currently have 3 dogs (Zeke, Marley and Buddie). From 1989 until November 2011, George was on Active Duty with the Florida National Guard and retired as a Sergeant Major. While with the Florida National Guard he served in many assignments including 2 years with the Special Forces Battalion in a support role, 9 years as an Explosive Ordnance Disposal Technician (aka Bomb Squad) and the final 11 years coordinating Florida National Guard support to the State of Florida in response to natural disasters and security operations. Towards the end of his military career, he took up running

again and qualified for the National Guard Marathon Team. In 2012, George received the State of Florida Governor's Hurricane Conference Distinguished Service Award for extraordinary leadership, professionalism, dedication, and commitment in the field of emergency response and disaster relief in the State of Florida.


After his military retirement in 2011, George became a defense contractor and led a team of emergency management and military professionals to develop and facilitate natural disaster and terrorism scenario exercises for the Department of Defense to respond to. In addition to creating the scenarios, his team also replicated FEMA and the scenario state response, developed their documents and products, and role-played FEMA and state officials to create a realistic training exercise for the DoD. George retired in May 2022 although he did return last spring for 2 exercises and he is once again retired.



As for running, George has run over 36,000 miles since 2007 including 46 marathons and 13 Ultras. He has won 2 marathons (2016 Ocala and 2017 Soldier Marathon) and has a PR of 2:51 and won 4 Ultra Marathons. His longest Ultra Marathon was the 260- mile Race Across Georgia in 2014 which he finished 2nd. George has also served as a Pacer for 19 marathons. He truly enjoys serving as a Pacer as he finds it so rewarding to help others achieve their goals.

George stepped up this year to serve as the Vice President of the Florida Striders and at the time he expressed his appreciation for the opportunity to serve and improve the club like the Boards and Officers he has served since 1978. Now it is the time for us to express our appreciation for him. He has gone over and above to support me as a first-time president and helped to implement changes and improvements that will benefit our club for years to come. Thank you, George! Thank you for your service to our country and for your time and service to the Florida Striders Track Club.

Although it rained well over an inch on Friday, we still had several runners camp out the night before the race. This is the only Strider race where we offer free camping the night before. One of the reasons we offer free camping is we always attract runners not only from around the state, but the country as well. This year was no exception with runners from Alabama, Colorado, Georgia, Illinois, Iowa, Louisiana, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas and Ontario, Canada. We were

truly blessed with great weather on Race Day with a low of 48 and a high of 71. It turned out to be

a great day and a great race! The weather and course conditions were so good that we had 4 new Course Records set!

Congratulations to the new Course Record Holders who are Regina Sooey, Kevin Sweeney, Eva George, and Allen Altman! This is the first year that we gave new Course Record Holders a custom plaque acknowledging their athletic



achievement.
Regina Sooey who previously held 2 course records (50k Female Overall and 50k Female Masters) lost the 50k Female Overall record but gained a new one with the



25k Female Grand Masters record. Regina was extremely

gracious and presented the new 50k Female Overall Course Record Holder Eva George with her Course Record Holder plaque.



In addition to the new Course Record Holders, we also had some excellent athletic performances by several runners who finished their first Ultra Marathon. Now that they've completed their first, I'm certain it won't be their last.

The runners not only got to experience the beauty of Cary State Forest, but they also got to eat plenty of great food. At the

Main Aid Station in addition to being well stocked with typical Ultra Marathon food, Florida Strider Mike Martinez with Sombrero Running Events and his crew were serving his famous chorizo and egg burritos. At our Pavilion Aid station, we served Ultra Marathon food and pulled pork sandwiches and potato salad for lunch.


